WED Sydney to Adelaide
Fly to Adelaide. Make your way to your accommodation and the rest of the day is at leisure.
Overnight: Grand Chifley Adelaide (Std), Mantra on Hindmarsh (Sup), Stamford Plaza Adelaide (Dlx), 2 nts

THU Adelaide
Today is a free day to explore this beautiful city or perhaps take an optional tour to the famous Barossa Valley.

FRI Adelaide to Kangaroo Island (L)
Early this morning you will join the scenic coach drive through the Fleurieu Peninsula to Cape Jervis, where you'll board the SeaLink ferry for your 45 minute cruise to Kangaroo Island. You will visit Clifford's Honey Farm, Birds of Prey show, Parndana Wildlife Park, visit Seal Bay for a beach walk amongst the Australian sea-lions, then on to Kingscote to see the daily pelican feeding.
Overnight: Ozone Seafront Hotel (Std), KI Seafront Hotel (Sup), KI Lodge (Dlx)

SAT Kangaroo Island to Adelaide (L)
Today visit the Emu Ridge Eucalyptus Distillery, Kelly Hill Caves where a National Parks guide will escort you deep into this fascinating cave system. After lunch, visit Flinders Chase National Park. Walk along the boardwalks to the spectacular Remarkable Rocks and Admirals Arch, before returning for your ferry and coach transfer back to Adelaide.
Overnight: Grand Chifley Adelaide (Std), Mantra On Hindmarsh (Sup), Stamford Plaza Adelaide (Dlx)

SUN Adelaide to Perth
Today fly to Perth. On arrival you will be transferred to your accommodation. The rest of the day is free to explore on your own, perhaps take a stroll through Kings Park or enjoy a cruise to Fremantle.
Overnight: Goodearth Hotel (Std), Mantra on Murray (Sup), Duxton Hotel (Dlx), 3 nights

MON Perth
Today choose from the following tours:

Option 1: Margaret River, Eagles, Caves, Wine and Cape Leeuwin tour includes morning tea at Dawesville Channel, wine tasting at Xanadu Winery, picnic lunch at the Eagle Heritage Raptor Centre, guided tour of Mammoth Cave, a stop at Cape Leeuwin Lighthouse and Busselton Jetty.
Option 2: 4WD Pinnacles, Beaches, Koalas and Sand Dunes tour includes Caversham Wildlife Park in the Swan Valley to view koalas and hand feed kangaroos, stop for a picnic lunch at the fishing town of Cervantes, Pinnacles Desert to view the limestone spires and 4WD and over the sand dunes of Lancelin.

TUE Perth
Today is a free day to do some further sightseeing of Perth. Perhaps you might like to take a day cruise to Rottnest Island or join the Swan Valley Wine Cruise.

WED - SAT The Nullarbor Plain - Kalgoorlie - Adelaide - Broken Hill - Blue Mountains - Sydney
This morning make your own way to the Perth Railway Station to board the Indian Pacific. For the next three days you will travel across the longest straight stretch of railway in the world - The Nullarbor Plain, through outback towns, the Blue Mountains and finally into Sydney where this epic journey comes to an end. Sit back and enjoy the scenery and onboard service.
Overnight: The Indian Pacific, 3 nights
