

Alice and the Rock

8 NIGHTS • ULURU (AYERS ROCK) • KINGS CANYON • ALICE SPRINGS • ADELAIDE • BAROSSA VALLEY

DAY 1 Melbourne/Hobart to Ayers Rock

Join your flight to Ayers Rock. On arrival you will be transferred to your accommodation. This afternoon enjoy a walk through Kata Tjuta (the Olgas), including a walk at Waipa Gorge. Travel to the sunset viewing area to enjoy nibbles and a complimentary glass of wine and watch the effect of the setting sun on the colour of Uluru. *Overnight: Outback Pioneer Hotel (Std), Desert Gardens Hotel (Sup), Sails in the Desert (Dlx)*

DAY 2 Uluru (Ayers Rock) to Kings Canyon

This morning join the Uluru Sunrise, Climb and Base Tour or for the non-climbers, the Uluru Sunrise and Guided Cultural Walk. Both tours include a visit to Mutitjula Waterhole and the Uluru-Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre. This afternoon you will travel to Kings Canyon Resort. *Overnight: Kings Canyon Resort*



DAY 3 Kings Canyon to Alice Springs

This morning join your guide for the rocky climb to the canyon rim for superb views of Watarrka National Park (for those with a good level of fitness). Alternatively explore the canyon floor (an easier, shady walk). Travel on to Alice Springs this afternoon. *Overnight: All Seasons Oasis (Std), Aurora Alice Springs (Sup), Alice Springs Resort (Dlx), 2 nights*

DAY 4 Alice Springs

Tour the sights of 'The Alice' including the historic Telegraph Station and the Royal Flying Doctor Service. Visit the School of the Air where sometimes we are able to listen to the children taking lessons 'on air'. Stop at the Alice Springs Reptile Centre where you will see unique Central Australian reptiles such as the Perentie and Thorny Devil. Conclude with a panoramic view of Alice Springs and the surrounding ranges from the top of Anzac Hill.

DAY 5 Alice Springs to Adelaide

This afternoon board The Ghan for your journey to Adelaide. *Overnight: The Ghan*

DAY 6 Adelaide

Arrive in Adelaide early this afternoon. You will be transferred to your accommodation and the rest of the day is free for you to explore this historic city. *Overnight: Grand Chifley Adelaide (Std), Mantra on Hindmarsh (Sup), Stamford Plaza Adelaide (Dlx), 3 nights*

DAY 7 Adelaide

This morning you will be collected from your accommodation and taken on a morning tour to discover the highlights of Adelaide including visits to Haigh's Chocolate Factory, the Glenelg Esplanade, Colonel Light's Lookout and drive past the world-famous Adelaide Oval, River Torrens, St Peter's Cathedral and North Terrace.

DAY 8 Barossa Valley (L)

Today visit the largest wine producing region in Australia, the world famous Barossa Valley. Taste premium award winning wines, view magnificent stone architecture and quaint boutique wineries, all encapsulated in a peaceful rural setting.

DAY 9 Adelaide to Melbourne/Hobart

Today you will be transferred to the airport in time to join your flight home.
